Marine



March was another busy month for the Marine sales team with exhibitions in Dubai, Istanbul and Vietnam, plus a visit from our Norwegian agent Servi.

Hepworth attended the Dubai Boat Show with our agent Brook Marine, who had built a big stand with working wiper displays on either end. Venu Kayyil and his team were, as ever, extremely helpful and the show itself was a real eye opener. Mainly aimed at yachts and their equipment, there were some incredibly expensive toys on show; a different area of the industry for us, as Hepworth are usually found exhibiting at offshore shows.

At the Istanbul exhibition we joined Mete Tarihmen and his team from Nemo Marine, our marine agent for Turkey. The exhibition was relatively quiet, however we will be making a return visit in May to visit previous, current and potential customers. Vietnam is one of the rising stars of shipbuilding, having recently become the 5th largest in the world by tonnage build (in 2010 they were 11th). The Inmex Vietnam exhibition was small in size but big in potential and there have already been a number of enquiries with more to follow, after many enthusiastic replies.

There were even surprise visits from Eugene Wee from Noah, and Aaron Smith and Samuel Huy from A.M.I, our agent in Australia. Servi visited us to showcase some of their own products in the hope of gaining our approval on further collaboration, which could have big consequences and increase our competitiveness considerably. Hepworth was happy to welcome them all and look forward to seeing them again, June 2 - 5 in Oslo for Norway's Norshipping exhibition.
