1. U.S. Coast Guard Cutter Stone

The newly-built national security cutter USCGC Stone has an unusual mission on her first cruise. Stone will deploy to the South Atlantic, a rarely visited area for the agency, in order to counter IUU fishing activity.

Stone got under way from Pascagoula, Mississippi on December 23, bound for a partnership and presence mission with the governments of Guyana, Brazil, Uruguay, Argentina and Portugal.



On board Stone are 22 Type C wipers with 3000-Series controllers with wash, purge, and power supply systems, supplied by our distributor in the USA [Inmar Systems](#).

2. USS Fort Lauderdale LPD 28

The San Antonio class ship amphibious transport dock will be able to support a Marine Air Ground Task Force across the spectrum of operations, conducting amphibious and expeditionary missions of sea control and power projection to humanitarian assistance and disaster relief missions throughout the first half of the 21st century.
